

May 14th, 2020

Mayor Boyko called the opening bids to order at 6:30 p.m. at the Civic Center with the following council members present: Kalmbach, Vigesaa, Sayler and Ballensky. Also present were Auditor Braithwaite, Chapman, Fischer, Travis Frey with Interstate Engineering, Project Advisor- John Phillips, Attorney Solem, bidders and approximately 6 residents.

Mayor Boyko reminded everyone that it was just to open bids, and no approval or accepting of street bids could be made until the protesting process was over. The protesting public hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, June 2nd at 6:30 p.m. at the Civic Center. Protest deadline is Friday, May 22nd.

Attorney Solem opened the bid envelopes for the Sewer and Street Improvement Projects. Frey with Interstate Engineering announced the following bids:

Alternate includes variations of asphalt removal, hot Bituminous patching, soil cement subgrade preparation and stabilization and Portland cement.

No estimate on alternate and replacing manholes.
